Millennium Year Perihelion

My Dear Friends,

Dr. Boff has communicated a rare and important ethereal message to me and to his loyal supporters on this plane of existence. The message is directed not only to his supporters but also to the idiots of the media who continue to refer to this as "The New Millennium," as they play the theme music from Arthur Clarke's "2001." Did they miss the point, or have they forgotten how to count? The latter is more likely as most of the media people have been taught the New Math.

The year 2000 is NOT the beginning of the 21st century nor the 3rd millennium. As Dr. Boff's colleague, Dr. Elena Poliakhova, has pointed out, "This is the last year of our (the 2nd) millennium." These are the important considerations related to the beginning of a new year, not because some emperor or king has decided to fix the calendar or the reference date, but because the Earth has come to its closest approach to the Sun. As the ancient Greeks said, "That which is closest, is bestest." I'm not sure which Greeks said this, but I'm sure that at least one of them did; if not, one of them should have. Dr. Boff's idea, and his admonition to us all, is that we should run East at midnight on perihelion so as to achieve the maximum speed attainable by an individual who runs (Eastward) as fast as he or she can. Some of Dr. Boff's students and colleagues have invented ingenious methods for achieving maximum speed at Earth's perihelion.
